SESSION STRUCTURE

PART A: WHY DOES MY CHILD SOMETIMES ACT DISRESPECTFULLY?

Check In

Goals

- Build the relationship
- Prepare for the session by checking for crises ("clearing the fog")
- □ Assess recent youth behavior

Activities

- □ Ask how the caregiver is doing
- □ Ask what has transpired since last contact
- □ Ask about progress of youth

Review – Not Applicable

Intervention

Goal

- Understand how adolescent brain development impacts respect
- Understand the features that make up respectful and disrespectful attitudes and behaviors

Activity

 Identify which features of respect and disrespect are most important to the caregiver

Assignment

Goal

 Understand that most of us acted disrespectfully as an adolescent and that it is a normal part of development

Activity

 Recall times caregivers (or friends of caregivers) acted disrespectfully as an adolescent

Note: it may take 2 or more sessions to cover the material depending on family circumstances
