
Spotlight on Females in the Pennsylvania Juvenile Justice System



Youth arrest trends, 2008-2015 Source: Pennsylvania State Police


Delinquency cases involving females were more likely to be diverted or receive a consent decree than cases involving males.



^{*}Approximately 3% of allegations were withdrawn.


