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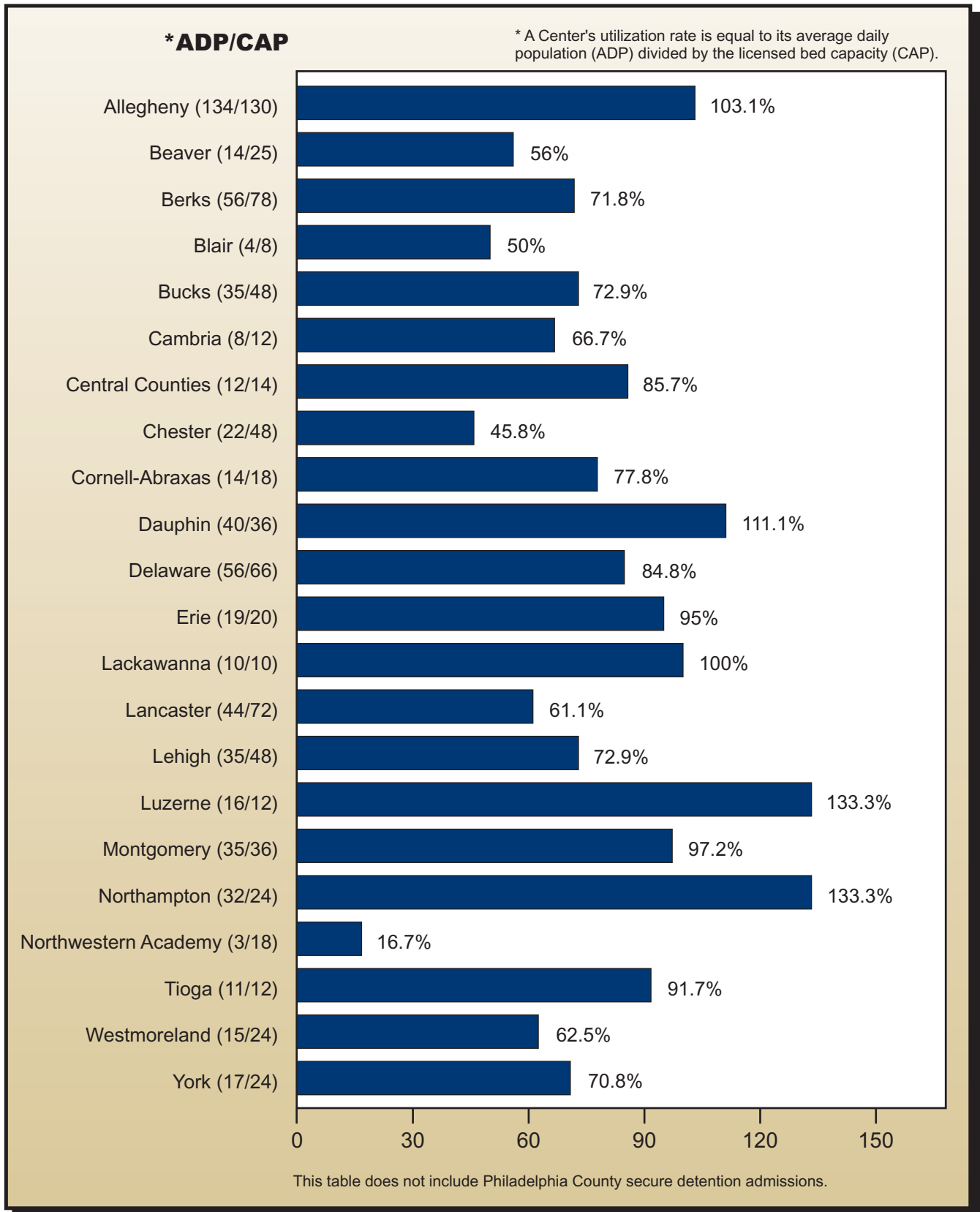

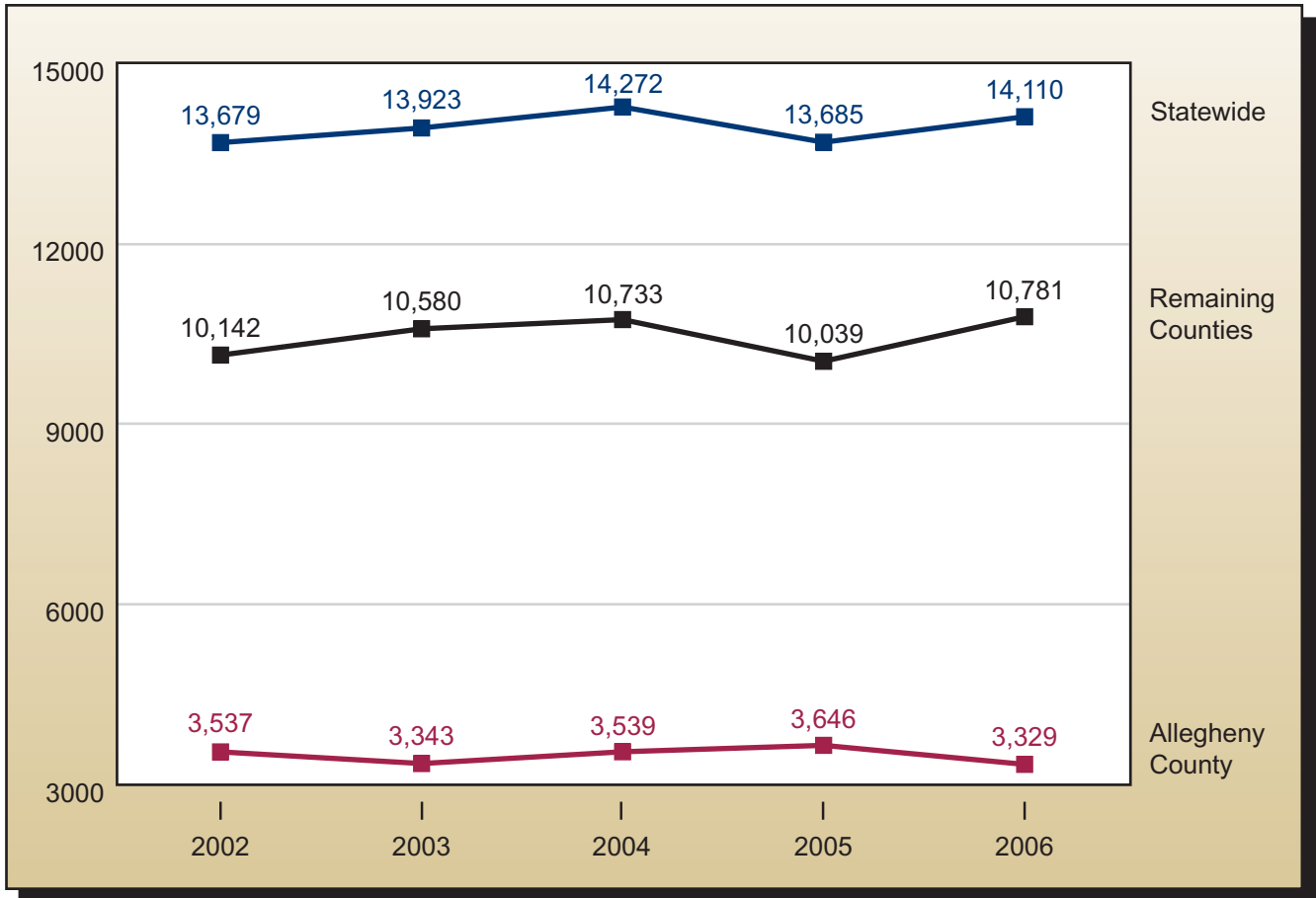
Utilization Rates for Pennsylvania Juvenile Detention Centers, 2006

In 2006, new admissions to secure detention totaled 14,110, which is a 3.1% increase from the number of statewide detention center admissions in 2005.

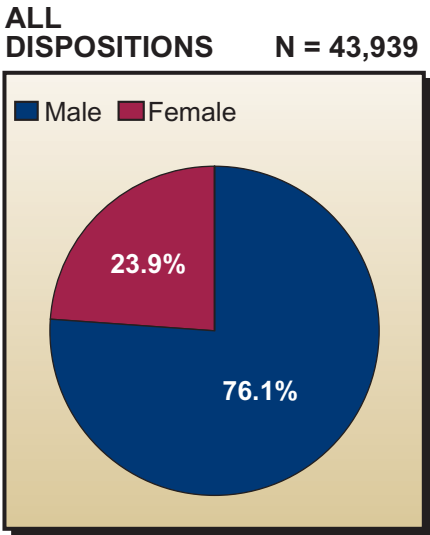
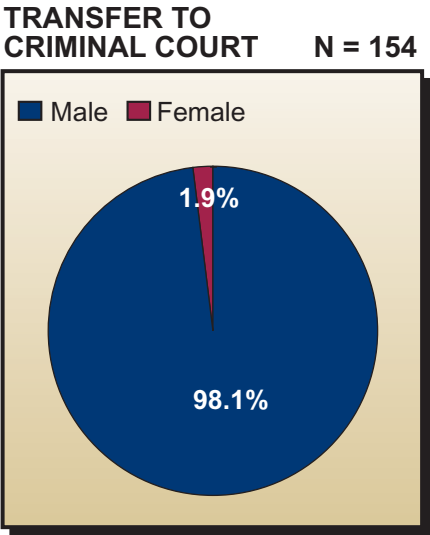
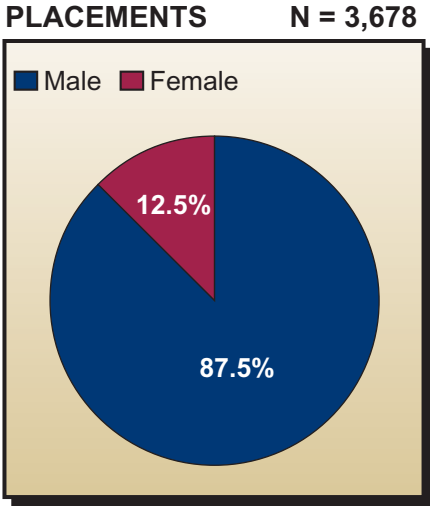
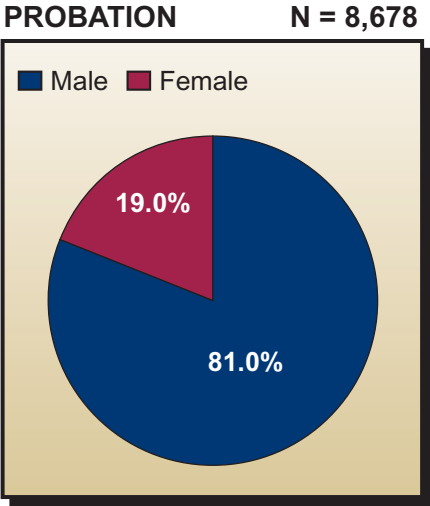
DETENTION ADMISSIONS

Selected Dispositions by Gender, 2006

Juvenile court dispositions in Pennsylvania's juvenile justice system primarily involved males. In 2006, males accounted for 76.1% of all juvenile court dispositions, 81.0% of probation dispositions, 87.5% of dispositions involving placement and 98.1% of transfers to criminal court.

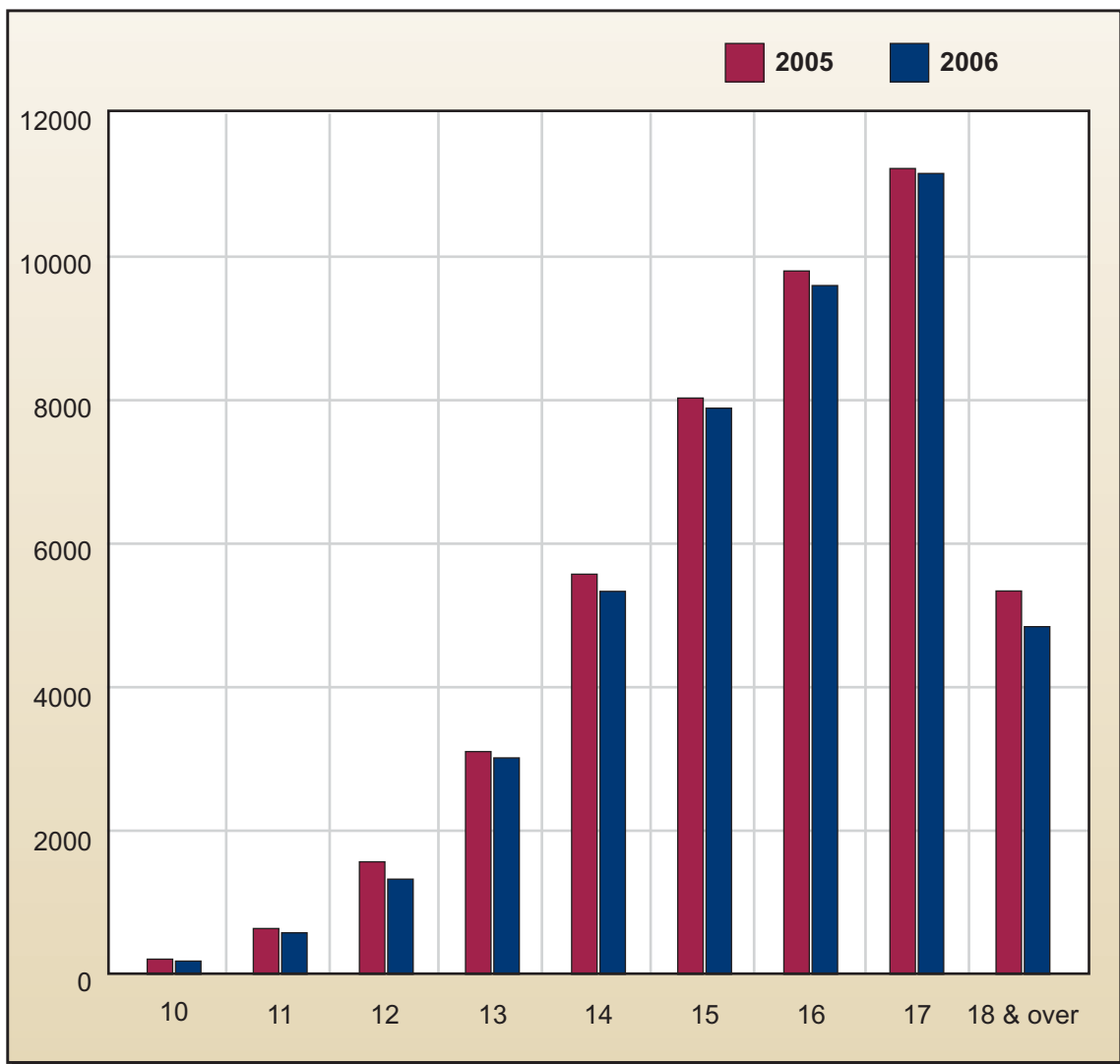


Total Dispositions by Age, 2005-2006

This table reflects total dispositions by age of the juvenile, at the time of disposition for 2005-2006 (see pages 51-54).

Seventeen year olds accounted for 11,160 (25.4%) of the 43,939 juvenile delinquency dispositions in 2006, representing the most dispositions for any age group. Juveniles who were age 16 accounted for 9,598 (21.8%), and juveniles who were age 15 accounted for 7,889 (18.0%) of the dispositions in 2006. This data remains consistent with that of 2005, in which seventeen year olds accounted for 24.7%, sixteen year olds accounted for 21.5% and fifteen year olds accounted for 17.6% of juvenile delinquency dispositions.

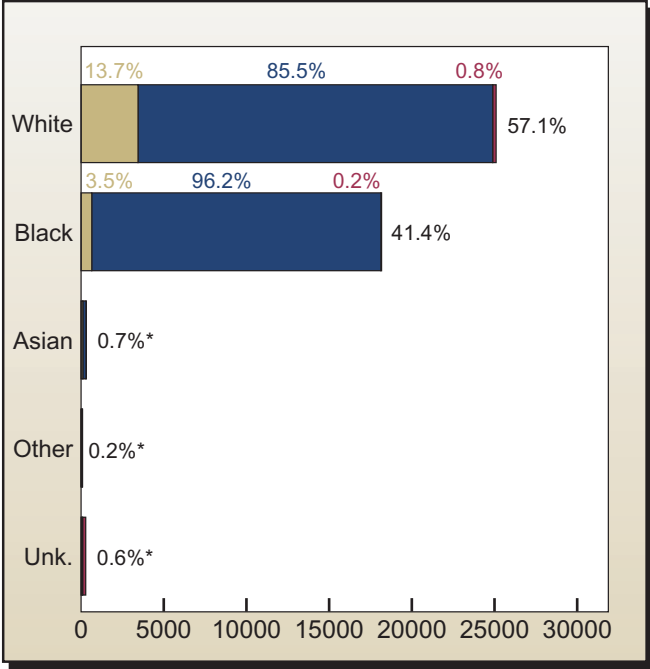

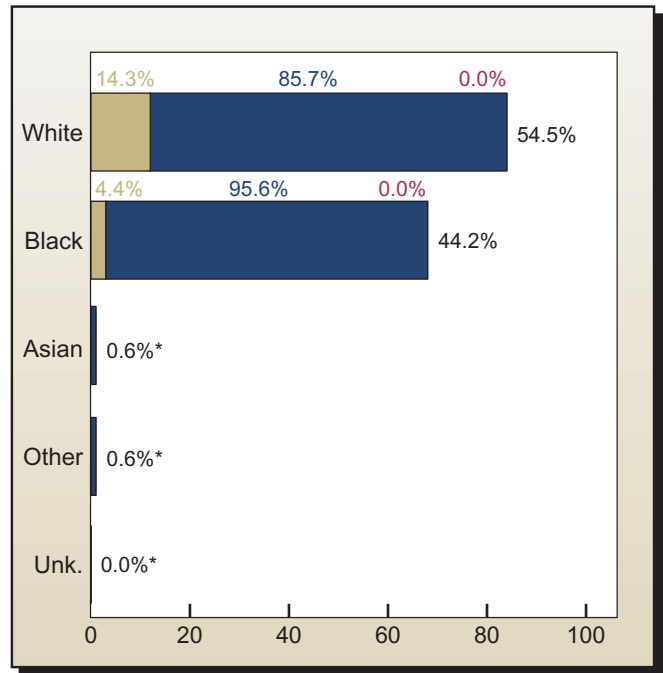
Selected Dispositions by Race and Ethnicity, 2006

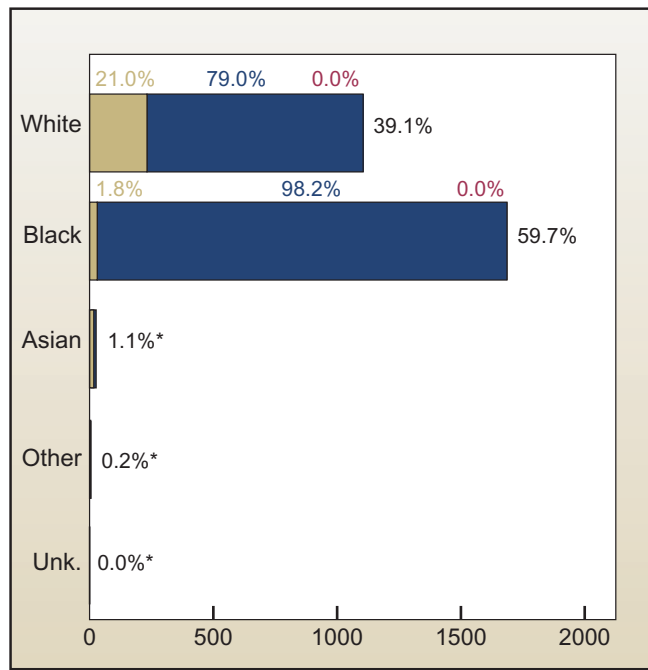

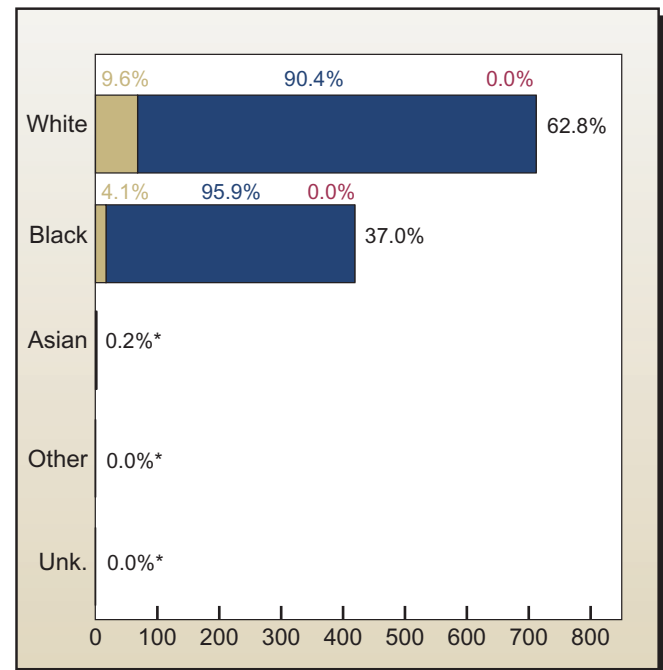


Selected Placements by Race and Ethnicity, 2006
