This table reflects the median length of stay in secure detention. The median is defined as the value above and below which half the cases fall. In 2004, the median length of stay in secure detention was 10 days, which is consistent with the last four reporting years.

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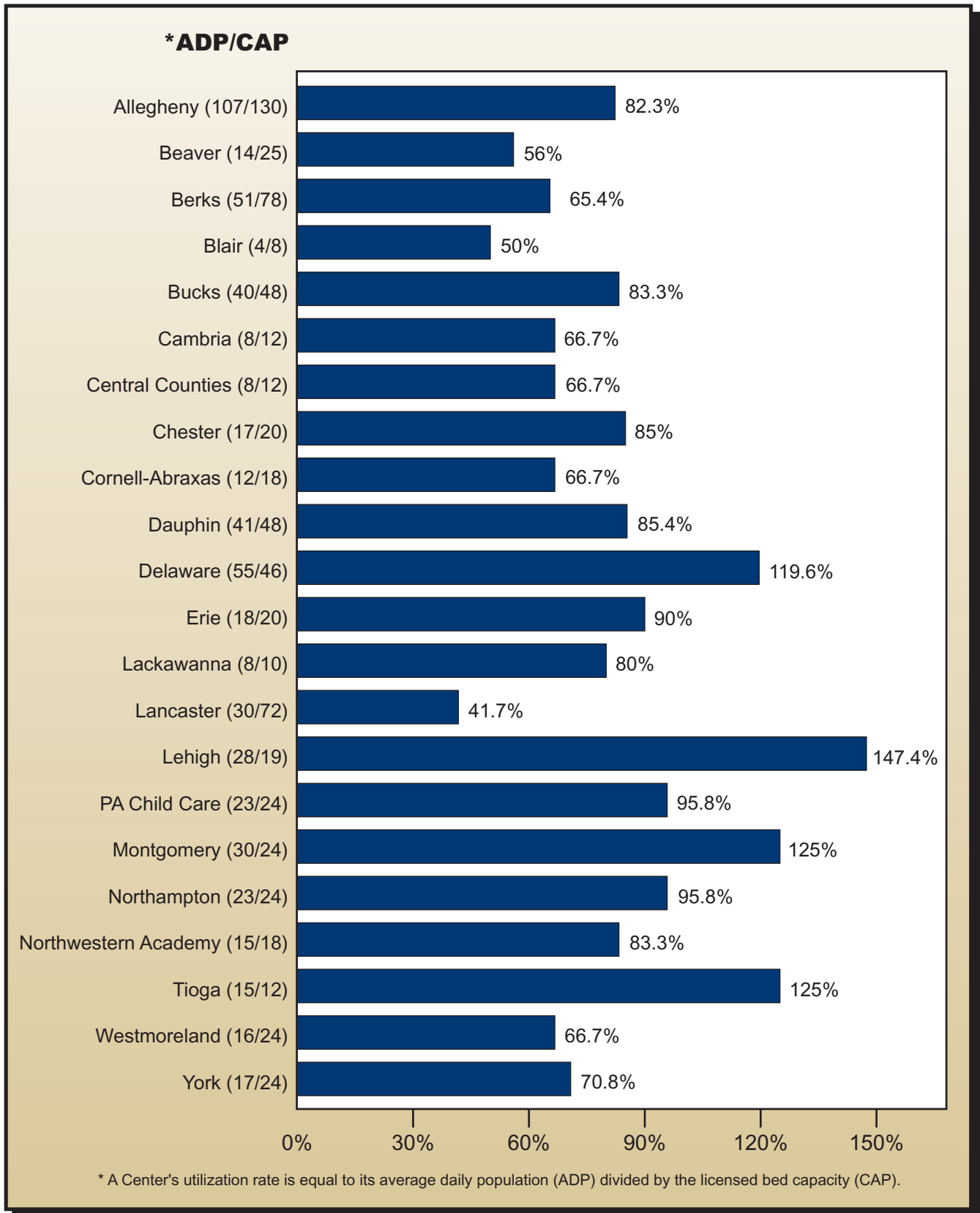

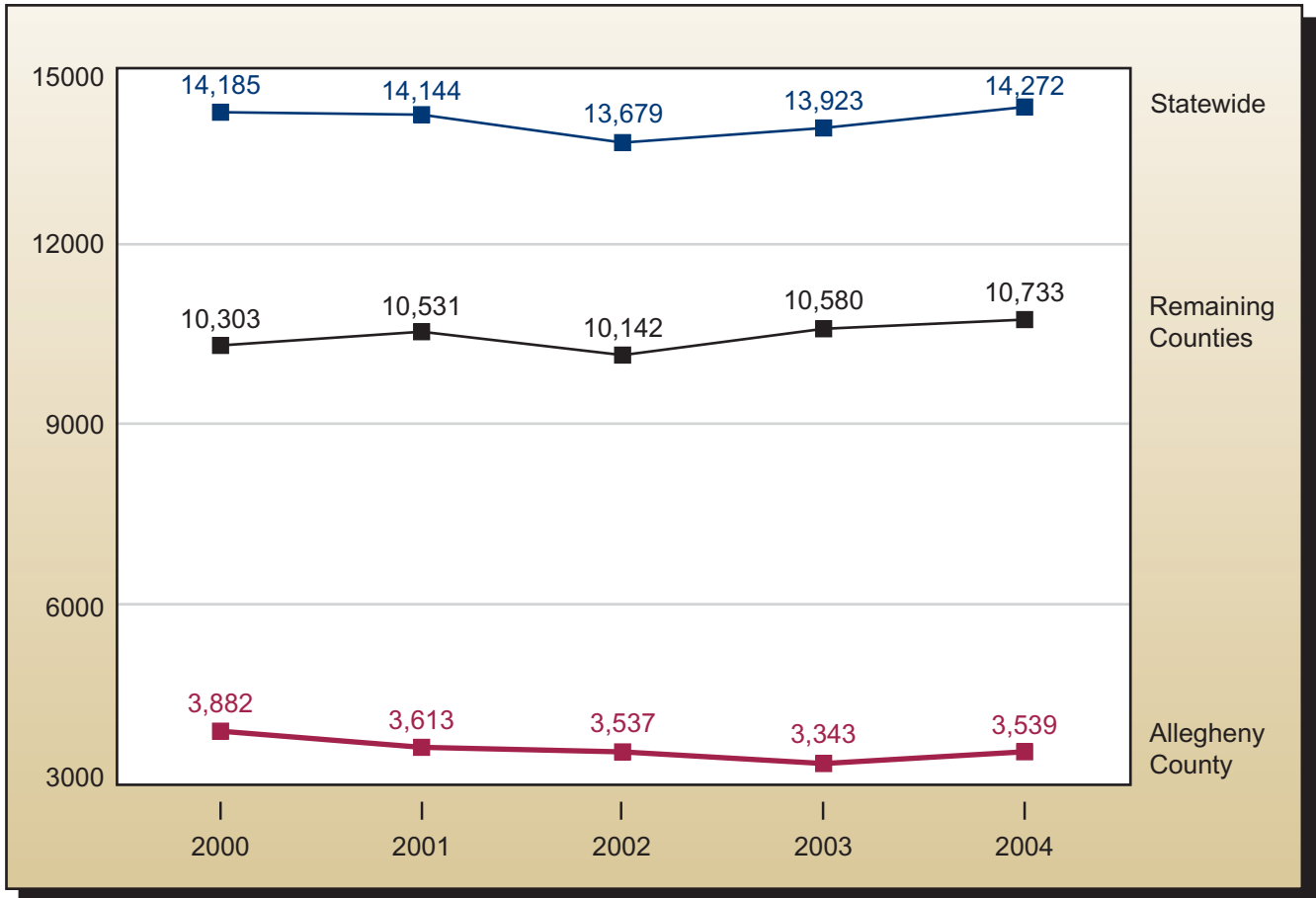
Utilization Rates for Pennsylvania Juvenile Detention Centers, 2004

In 2004, new admissions to secure detention totaled 14,272, which is a 2.5% increase from the number of statewide detention center admissions in 2003.

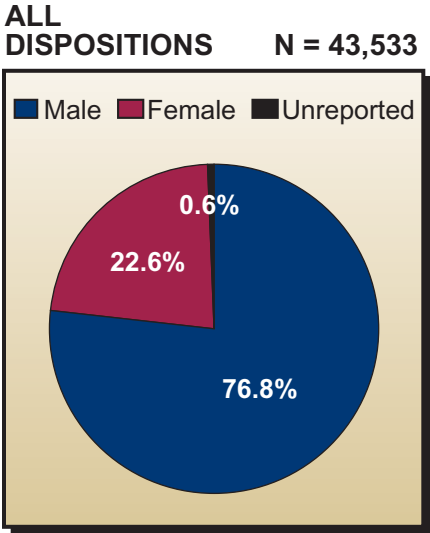
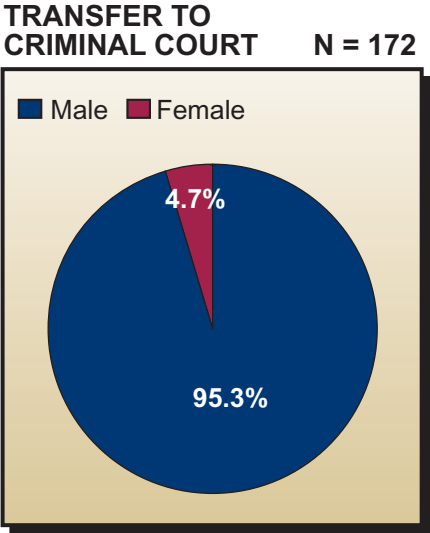
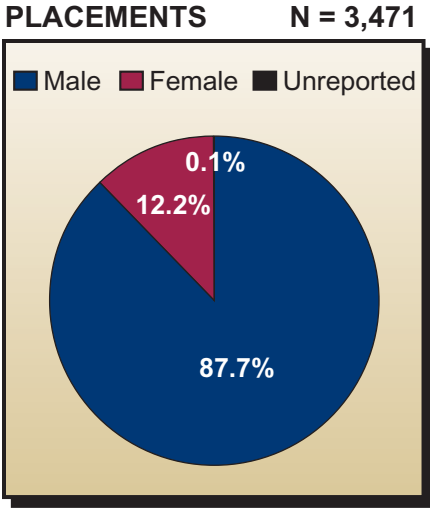
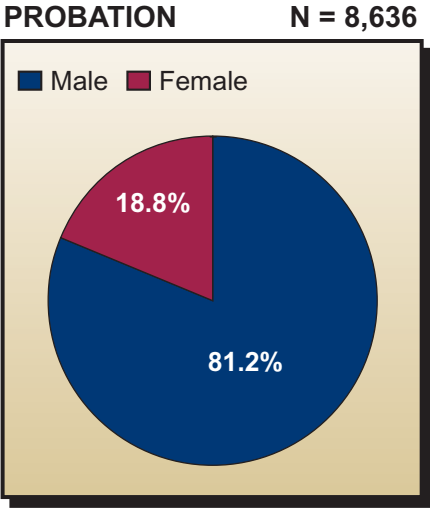
DETENTION ADMISSIONS

Selected Dispositions by Gender, 2004

Juvenile court dispositions in Pennsylvania's juvenile justice system primarily involved males. In 2004, males accounted for 76.8% of all juvenile court dispositions, 81.2% of probation dispositions, 87.8% of dispositions involving placement and 95.3% of transfers to criminal court.

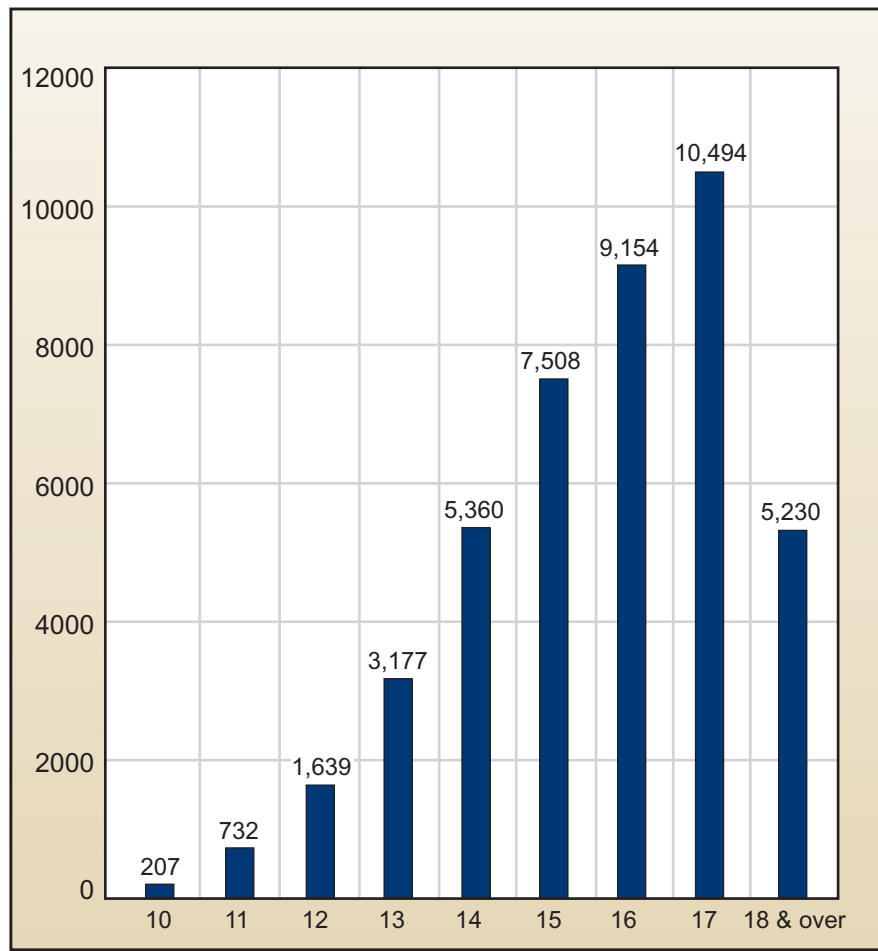


Total Dispositions by Age, 2004

This table reflects the age of the juvenile at the time of disposition.

Seventeen year olds accounted for 10,494 (24.1%) of the 43,533 juvenile delinquency dispositions in 2004, representing the most dispositions for any age group. Juveniles who were age 16 accounted for 9,154 (21.0%), and juveniles who were age 15 accounted for 7,508 (17.2%) of the dispositions in 2004.

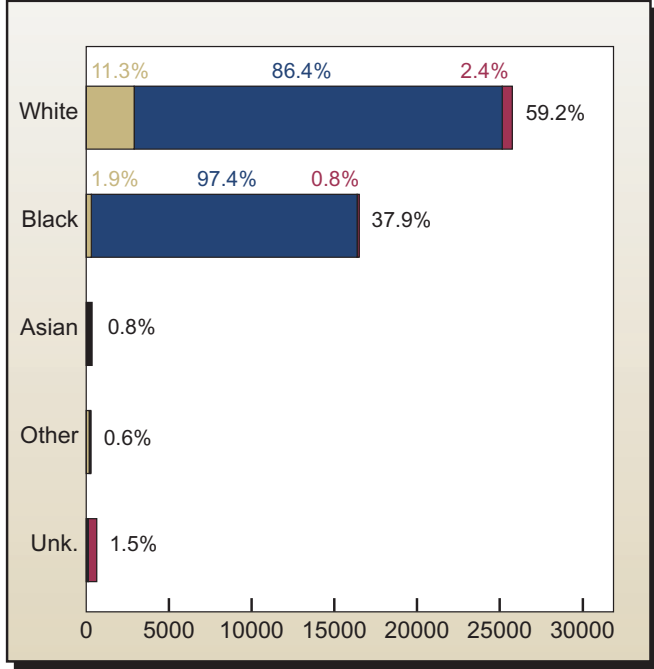

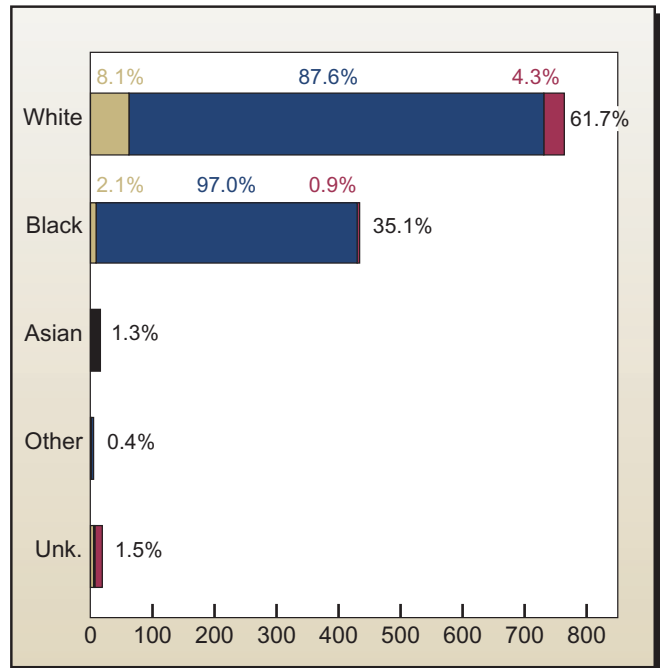


Selected Placements by Race and Ethnicity, 2004
