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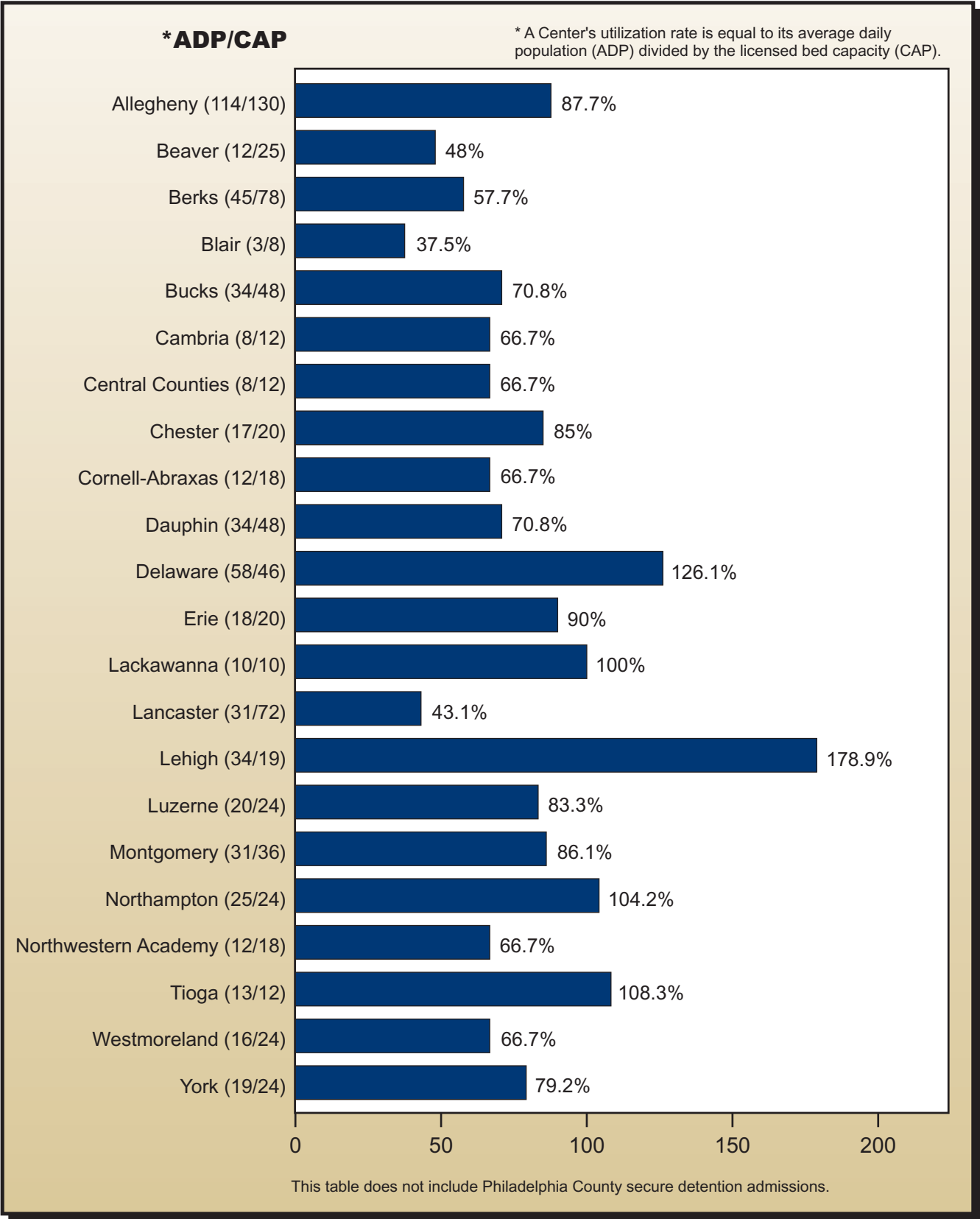

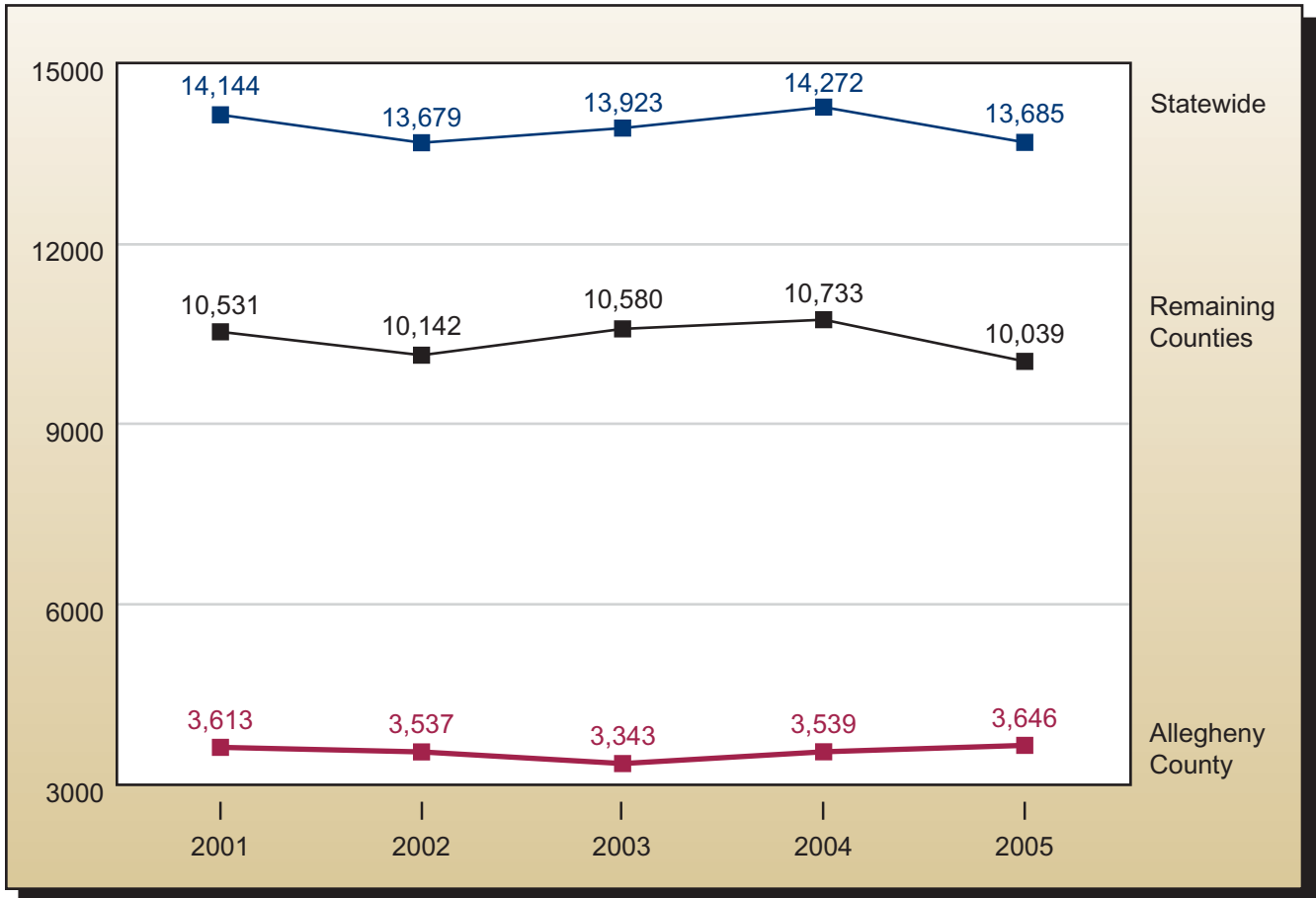
Utilization Rates for Pennsylvania Juvenile Detention Centers, 2005

In 2005, new admissions to secure detention totaled 13,685, which is a 4.1% decrease from the number of statewide detention center admissions in 2004.

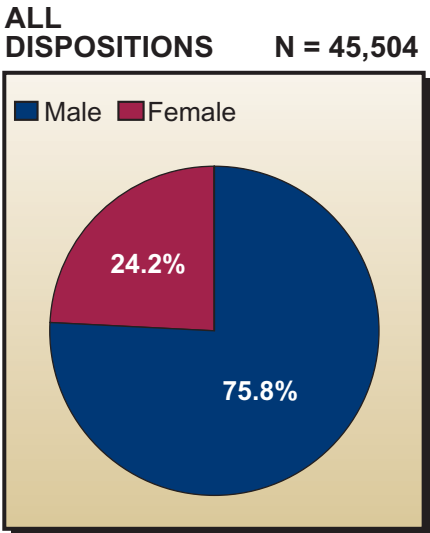
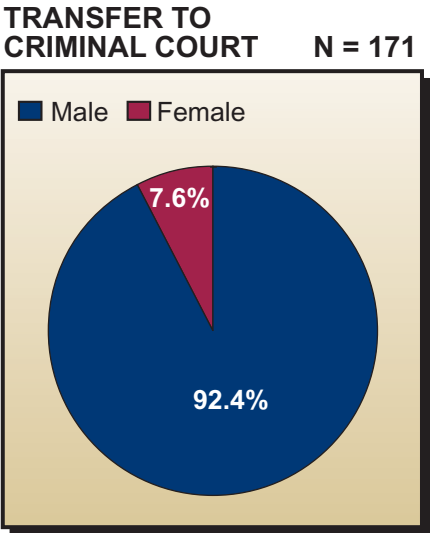
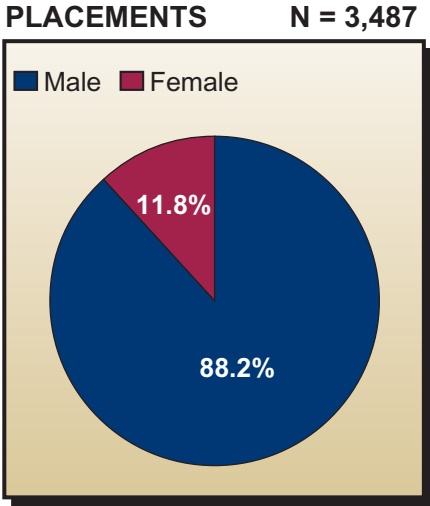
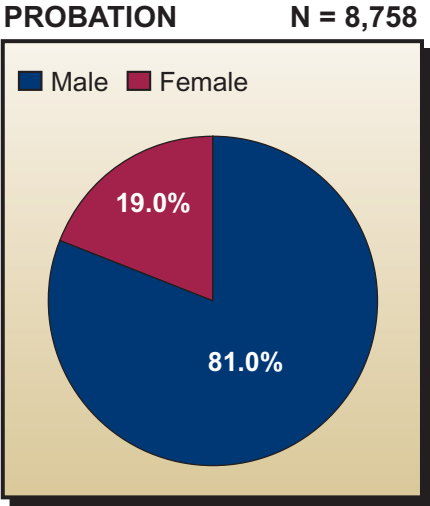
DETENTION ADMISSIONS

Selected Dispositions by Gender, 2005

Juvenile court dispositions in Pennsylvania's juvenile justice system primarily involved males. In 2005, males accounted for 75.8% of all juvenile court dispositions, 81.0% of probation dispositions, 88.2% of dispositions involving placement and 92.4% of transfers to criminal court.

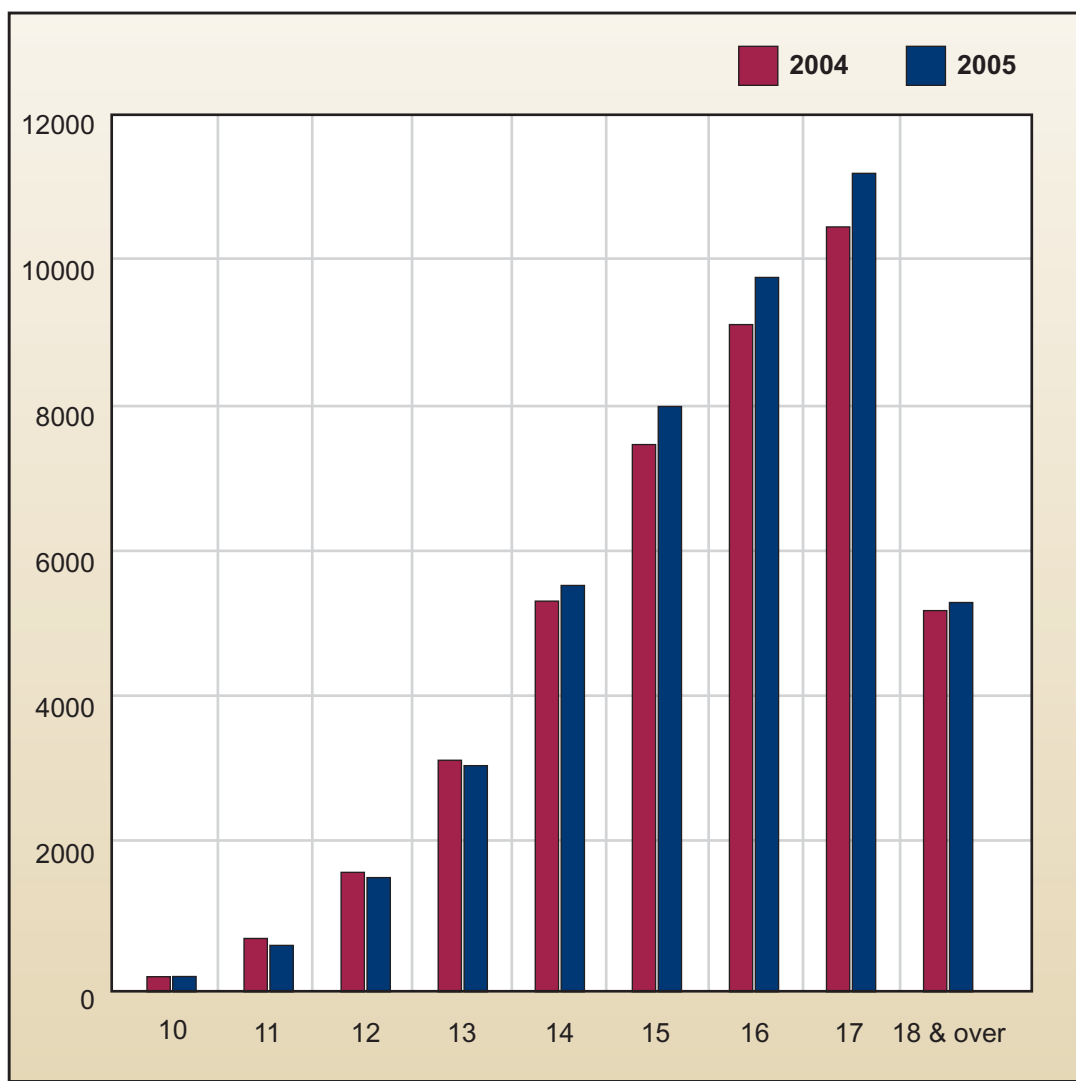


Total Dispositions by Age, 2004-2005

This table reflects total dispositions by age of the juvenile, at the time of disposition for 2004-2005 (see pages 51-54).

Seventeen year olds accounted for 11,229 (24.7%) of the 45,504 juvenile delinquency dispositions in 2005, representing the most dispositions for any age group. Juveniles who were age 16 accounted for 9,801 (21.5%), and juveniles who were age 15 accounted for 8,030 (17.6%) of the dispositions in 2005. These data remain consistent with that of 2004, in which seventeen year olds accounted for 24.1%, sixteen year olds accounted for 21.0% and fifteen year olds accounted for 17.2% of juvenile delinquency dispositions.

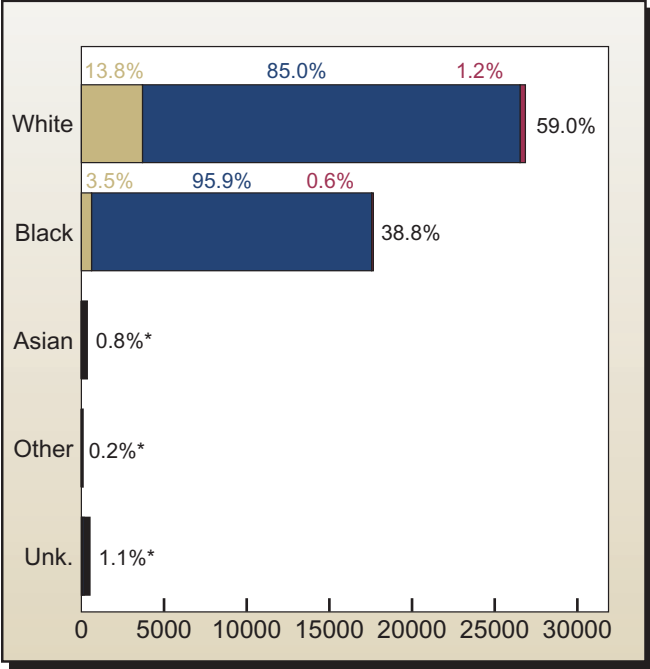

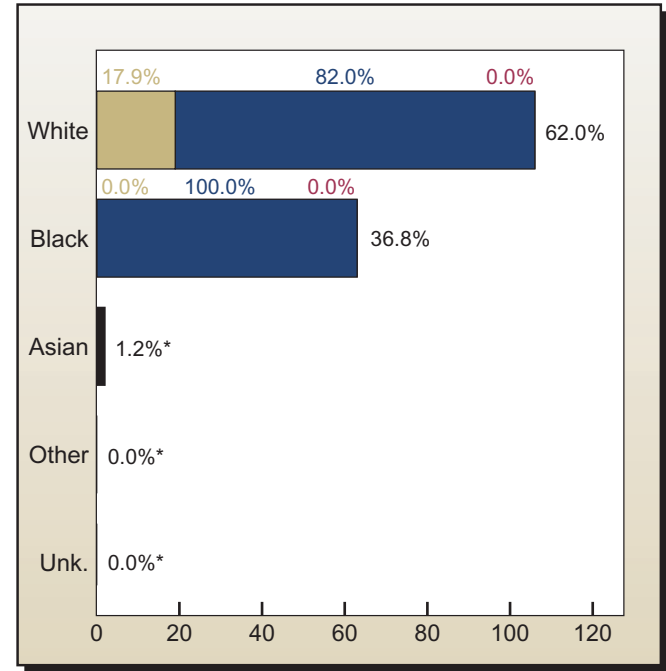
Selected Dispositions by Race and Ethnicity, 2005

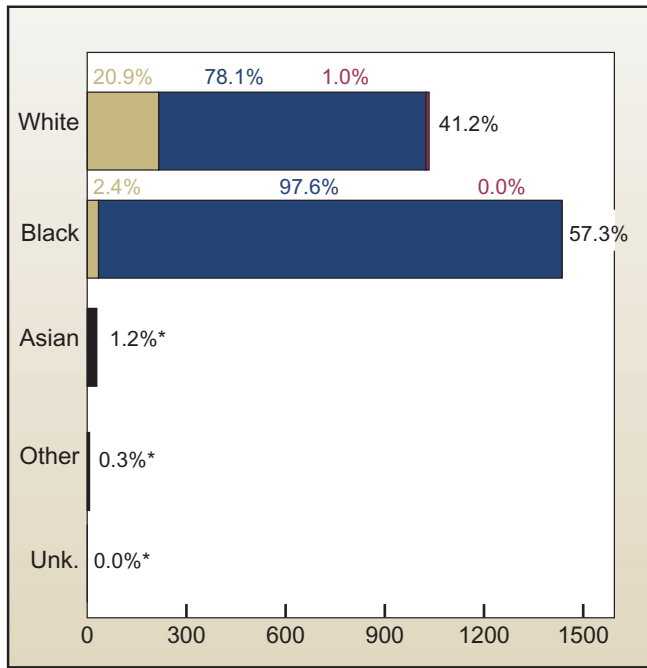

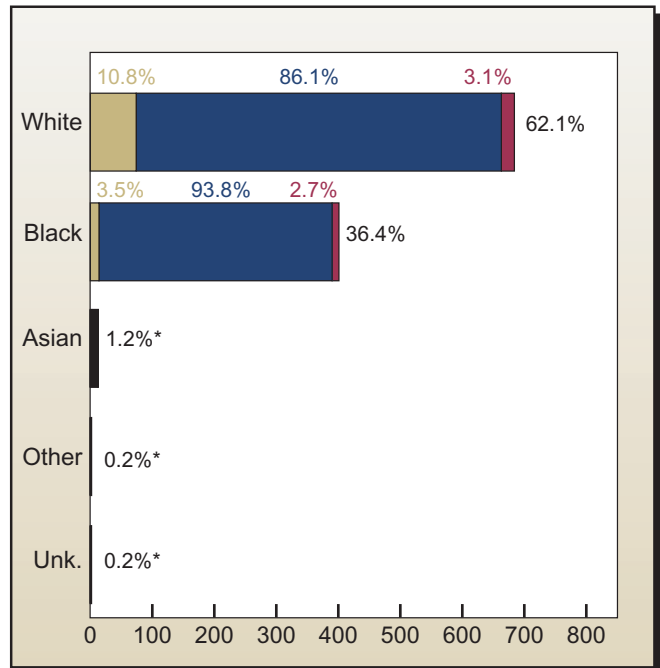


Selected Placements by Race and Ethnicity, 2005
